As they slip directly onto the blades, universal fit buckets stay on the machine and are a lot less vulnerable to destruction. Compared to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are 50% deeper. This extra space makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads such as backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles and broken up concrete.
